While this church's intent is to use all designated gifts for the specific purposes and projects designated, the final authority for the use of all gifts to the church rests with the Church.

Therefore, a written agreement of the donor and the Church regarding the gift and the terms of its donation shall be signed and placed in the Church's permanent records.

Absent any special conditions in the agreement, the Church is presumed to have the right to dispose of the memorial, if and when its care and maintenance becomes unreasonably burdensome, or the mission of the Church can best be fulfilled by its disposal. In such cases, the Trustees and Church Council will make a decision as to whether the memorial is to be donated, sold or otherwise.

In exceptional circumstances where the designated purposes are no longer feasible, or has been completed, or for other good cause, the Trustees and the Church Council may redirect such gifts to other appropriate ministries or projects, retaining the spirit of the original purpose of the gift.

**Cokes Chapel UMC Trustee
Memorial Gift Policy:**

- Bequests, trusts, given to Cokes Chapel, including “planned giving,” or “endowment giving” will be maintained as requested through the direction of the plan documents. The Church Council may determine that there should be a Trust Committee established to maintain use and activity over these designated gifts.
- Special purpose giving may need further approval of the Trustee Board and Church Council. (such as alterations to the physical structure of the church)
- From time to time the Trustees and Church Council, will solicit and establish a specific list of suggested Trustee Memorial giving.
- All gifts of Memorial are assumed to be irrevocable and intended for use immediately unless otherwise directed in writing. Refer to the policy for restrictions.
- Donations to Cokes Chapel UMC Trustee Memorial are Tax deductible.
