

## HEAD USHER STATEMENT

***[To be read by an usher to each group attending by vehicle as they pull into the worship space]...***

On March 11, 2020, The World Health Organization declared the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, a pandemic. COVID-19 is highly contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. Cokes Chapel UMC has put precautions in place to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, we **cannot guarantee** that you or your family, including your child(ren), will not become exposed to or infected with COVID-19 as a result of your attendance and participation in the service today. If you feel your health and safety is at risk please know we understand if you choose at this time not to remain at our service. If you remain on the premises we ask that you:

- A. Remain six or more feet away from anyone attending the service who is not part of your party;
- B. Wear a mask anytime you are moving around the grounds. Once seated, your mask may be removed if you prefer;
- C. Sanitize your hands frequently along with any common surfaces you come in contact with.
- D. Notify church authorities immediately should you or anyone in your party become ill with Covid symptoms, test positive for the virus or be exposed to anyone who has tested positive with in the last 14 days.

We also ask that you verbally agree not to sue CCUMC should you or a member of your party test positive and you agree to hold CCUMC harmless for any illness or injury that might occur as a result of the virus.
